STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£2345
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1350
 Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death 	£200
(Within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) and bringing into our care during normal work hours.	
 Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our (the funeral director's) premises. 	£0
 Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from a veneered wood available in stock (other makes of coffins are available at additional cost – please request prices from your Funeral Arranger) 	£545
 Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer) No charge is made. 	£0
 At a date and time, you agree with us the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse with Conductor and 4 Bearers. 	£250

UNATTENDED FUNERAL (Sometimes referred to as a Direct or Simple funeral.)

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (Funeral Director's charge only Mon-Fri. Please add the burial fee.¹)

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot*; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation, or Unattended cremation local to the Funeral Director, the cremation fee.² In this local area Mon-Fri the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:
